

General Assembly Band Booster Meeting Minutes 10/5/15

- Meeting brought to order at 6:00 p.m.
- Previous minutes were read and approved
- September expenses from their respective categories were reviewed:

\$248.79 for concession stand

\$490.22 for pages and flip books

\$1500 for drill writer

\$880.87 for rifles and silks

\$21.50 for treasurer's dividers and sleeves

\$511.96 was removed from petty cash, 500.00 was placed in the Fundraising budget and 11.96 paid a receipt for pot luck dinner expenses.

\$105.46 was used from trailer maintenance, however; some of this money was used for instrument repair and will be reimbursed to band boosters by Mr. Martin from the school band.

- Band schedule from the website was reviewed
- Vice President informed us that Chick-Fil-A in December will not be a fundraiser this year, but that an ensemble from band will still be performing. This should be noted on the website.
- It was noted that progress is being made on the planning for Rhythm Run in the spring.
- A suggestion was made to have door prizes available during the Oktoberfest fundraiser at Leonardtown Pub using our free Spirit Gear and adding tickets the Homecoming football game, purchased by Band Boosters, to the prize packages. After discussion it was approved by electronic and in person voting to only use the free items from Spirit Gear for prizes and not purchase tickets to the game.
- It was voted on and approved to hold a 50/50 raffle from 4-9 p.m. during Oktoberfest.
- The Band Booster organization status with the state of Maryland has been in forfeiture for some time and it has become urgent to change this status. Due to the urgency of obtaining good standing with the state a motion was made to pay an expense of \$90.00 plus gas money for the Board president and another representative to drive to Annapolis on October 9th to expedite the process. The motion was approved by the board using electronic voting.
- Questions were raised regarding the use of the building for concessions during football games. It has been said that the athletic director believes we are responsible for obtaining Health Department licenses for ALL concession users in lieu of having to pay 20% of our profits for building use. It was decided that all of our volunteers direct such questions to Mr. Martin to discuss with the athletic director as this a staff issue. We will continue as we are for this season and revisit the issue as more information is available from Mr. Martin.

- Mr. Martin said that the Marching Band will be holding a fundraising concert prior to the bon fire during spirit week. Tickets will be sold for \$1.00 each.
- Changes are going to be made for Senior Night at the last home football game. Details will be worked out by band and football staff members.
