Tri County Band Scale Requirements 2015-16:

(from page 41 in the SMMC manual)

### Middle School:

Two major scales selected from C, D, Eb, F, G, A, Bb, and the Bb Concert Chromatic Scale. Scales will be selected by the adjudicators prior to the beginning of the audition. No credit will be given for unplayed scales or scales that are not memorized.

## High School:

Two major scales selected from C, D, Eb, E, F, G, Ab, A, Bb, and the Bb Concert Chromatic Scale. Scales will be selected by the adjudicators prior to the beginning of the audition. No credit will be given for unplayed scales or scales that are not memorized.

# For all levels:

These scales will be Major scales and not Concert pitch, except for the chromatic scale. Flutes and Bb and Eb clarinets will play all the above scales for two octaves. All other instruments will play one octave. Scales are to be played in eighth note pattern ascending and descending. MM quarter note = 72 or faster. Scales may be slurred or tongued.

The only instruments not expected to play scales are snare drum and tympani. Mallets are expected to play scales in the same fashion as stated above.

Students with snare drums will play three of the following rudiments from slow to fast to slow:

- Flam taps
- Flam accent 1
- Ruff (drag)
- Paradiddle
- Single stroke long roll
- Double stroke long roll
- Five stroke roll
- Nine stroke roll
- Buzz roll p<f>p (closed roll)

Percussion players shall audition on two out of three instruments including snare drum, tympani, and/or mallets.
