

Leonardtwn High School
Band General Assembly Meeting
14 September 2015

Meeting came to order at 6:00 with the reading of the minutes. There was a change that needed to be made on the previous minutes. This will be revised. Introductions were made and the Treasurer report was passed around.

VICE PRESIDENT

- Some Dine-to-Donates have been set up. Ledos pizza is October 13, Panera will be in November and Chic-Fil-A will be in December. At Chic-Fil-A, the kids will be able to play music during the allotted time of the fundraiser.
- The Dine-to-Donates that have been chosen do not require a paper to receive proceeds.
- The goal is to have one Dine-to-Donate a month.
- The quilt will be ready next Wednesday. Would like to sell raffle tickets for the quilt at football games.
- The deadline for the raffle has not been determined yet.
- Work descriptions have been submitted to Mr. Martin so volunteers know what to do in the job they are signing up for. Once approved, they will be posted to the website.

CONCESSIONS

- Expenses for Game #1 = \$700.69. Income for Game #1 = \$1,534.45. Net Proceeds = \$833.76
- Chic-Fil-A suggested selling sandwiches/nuggets from \$4.00 to \$4.75 so the decision was made to increase them to \$4.50 (they were \$4.00). The cost for French Fries increased by \$.50 from \$1.50 to \$2.00.
- Forgot to increase the combo meals for the first game but they have been increased now. Hamburger/Cheeseburger/Hotdog combo meals went up by \$.50 and Chic-Fil-A combo meals went up by \$1.00 (\$.50 for CFA increase and \$.50 for FF increase).
- The Band kids will still pay the old prices for their pre-paid meals.
- Been in contact with the QB club with respect to prices and amounts of Chic-Fil-A to order. Information has been provided to them to get their Temp Food License and offered to help. Have not heard back about the license.
- More Chic-Fil-A sandwiches/nuggets will be ordered for the next game since everything was sold out before the first quarter. Total order is now 65 sandwiches and 40 nuggets. 20 sandwiches/nuggets are already spoken for for the season. Chic-Fil-A gave 20 free cookies to sell and consider buying for future games, but they didn't sell.
- Season dinner orders went over really good. 22 kids ordered for the season, so far. Will be at school Wednesday and Thursday after practice to take dinner orders/money for game on Friday.
- Propane was donated by Suburban. A thank-you letter will be sent to them. Total donated was worth \$68.09 (16.1 gal x \$3.99 +6% tax).
- The volunteer sign up has been rearranged a bit so that it's clear who is outside wrapping food/running fries and who's inside. Still need volunteers for this Friday's game.
- A generic auto-reminder emails will be sent for all events that volunteers sign up for.

PIT CHAIRPERSON

- The Boosters is in desperate need of a shed. The Leonardtown Volunteer Rescue Squad has one they are getting rid of. The Boosters offered \$200 to buy it from them. The shed will not be available until January/February timeframe. It will need some work so a fundraiser has been set

up at Old Town Pub on October 14, 2015. Once Mr. Martin approves, this will be on the website. The shed has been approved to go where the trailer currently is. This was voted on and approved by the board.

- Money will be spent in the near future on wheels for the trailer.

- No movement on this yet.

PRESIDENT

- The trailer decal is on!!! Almost finished, just a couple finishing touches left to be done.
- The FanCloth fundraiser raised \$300
- Possibly doing a concert during Homecoming week. More information to come.

- Before meetings, the schedule on the website will be reviewed and updated. Next General Assembly meeting scheduled for October 5, 2015.
