

April 18, 2016 General Assembly Minutes

- Meeting called to order at 6:00
- Minutes from previous meeting read and approved
- The meeting with the Athletic Director regarding concession stand usage for next season was postponed. We discussed the need for more volunteers and cost of having a larger concession sale.
- The financial report was read and passed around for review
- We now have \$2200 in 5k sponsorships. \$150 still remains to be paid for race day timers. The minimum t-shirt order is 25 shirts and will be ordered through Chesapeake Custom Embroidery.
- The calendar was discussed and has been made up to date by webmaster.
- It was brought up that we should maybe reconsider having dinner brought to students (at cost) during marching band camp. Some feel that students miss having the group brought together, others that they enjoy the break and getting to choose their meal daily. Discussed maybe providing dessert only, dinner 1 time a week, or having grill for burgers. It was also discussed that we would need parent support for all of these suggestions. More discussion and decisions will be made in the future.
- The trailer title has been changed and the inspection completed. Total cost was \$110.
- Mrs. Pugh designed "Band Together" shirts that will be available for sale. She will donate all proceeds after recovering the cost to have them made. They will be \$15 each.
- No mulch sales were made by the band
- The Booster president is turning in required paperwork to the school system pertaining to our organization.
- The shed we purchased from Leonardtown Fire Dept. will be ready for us in the fall.
- All board positions for band boosters are open and need to be filled in order for the organization to remain next school year. Mr. Martin will be sending out an urgent e-mail to parents following our meeting stating our dire need.
- The 5k race is on 4/30. Volunteers are needed for water station, course direction, spirit gear sales, set up and clean up. Mr. Wilkerson will be on site for medical. Kona Ice and Calvert Kettle Corn will be on site during the event. Kona will donate 20% of sales and Calvert Kettle Corn will donate 10%. We will be asking if we can hang flyers to advertise at the Spring Festival that is held at the fair grounds on Thursday and Friday.
- Discussed coordinating with the Tech Center for the banquet meal, selling spirit gear, needing pictures for slide show, and setting up king and queen jars.
- Wheels for the marching band tractor are on hold right now.
- It was discussed that Oktoberfest at Leonardtown Pub may become an annual event. It is being looked into by Mr. Wilkerson
