Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

At last, we are beginning the process toward our competition trip! We are excited and exhilarated to see our students perform and learn in Orlando, Florida. However, before we can board the buses and get on that stage, there is a long process to prepare for this event.

We will be leaving Leonardtown High School on the evening of Wednesday, April 4, 2018 and returning in the morning on Sunday, April 8, 2018. All students are invited to participate, but no one is required to do so. This is a completely voluntary trip and obviously will involve students staying overnight in assigned hotels.

The primary purpose of this trip is to perform in the Disney workshops, organized by Disney Performing Arts. Students and Chaperones will get the opportunity to enjoy the wonderful world of Disney and Universal Studios. These jam packed days will include a full day at Universal Studios, Epcot and Magic Kingdom!

Unfortunately, this jam-packed weekend does not come without a price. Each student must fundraise or pay \$875 for the trip fees. The details of the fees and everything they include will be itemized in this handbook.

In this handbook, there are several forms that must be filled out, signed, and submitted before a student can participate. Please read this handbook very carefully so that all forms and fees are turned in on time and following appropriate procedures.

Rules of Conduct

Any student who does not adhere to these standards of conduct will no longer be allowed to participate in the competition trip. NO EXCEPTIONS will be made and no refunds will be given to students who have been excluded.

In the event that a student breaks one of these rules, the student will be subject to disciplinary action, and they may be required to leave the competition and return to Leonardtown at their parent's expense. As always, NO REFUNDS will be given.

- 1. Students will follow all LHS school rules while participating in the trip. Refer to the SMCPS handbook for more details.
- Students will be assigned to a chaperone for the duration of the trip. Students must report to their assigned chaperone whenever instructed to do so. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 3. Students will not engage in any illegal activities, including smoking, drinking alcoholic beverages, or the use of illegal drugs. Violators will be prosecuted as appropriate.
- Students will not be permitted to visit hotel rooms of students of the opposite gender FOR ANY REASON.
- 5. Any inappropriate physical interaction between students will result in immediate dismissal from the trip.
- 6. Students will stay at their specified areas for the duration of the trip.
- 7. All prescription medication information MUST be provided to the student's director and their respective chaperone. This is the ONLY medication to be in the student's possession.

Calling all available Chaperones!

We are looking for available parents/guardians to serve as chaperones for this trip! If you are interested, you will likely be responsible for the following:

- Checking in students for events
- Keeping track of students assigned to you
- · Keeping order among students assigned to you
- Bed-checks at the end of each day at the hotel
- Reporting on any student discipline issues

Fees

Fortunately, the company that is organizing the trip offers the chaperones a discount in price. They only need pay \$450.00 to participate. If you wish to do so, chaperones may earn their trip fees through fundraising as well. Please see the fundraising information for details. All fees are to be paid on the same schedule as the students. Equally, medical information forms, VOLUNTEER FORMS, and commitment forms must be completed by all chaperones for emergency preparation purposes.

Explanation of Forms

Student Participation Commitment Form (Due November 21st)

Students and parents must complete and sign this form in order to declare that you commit to participating in this competition. Once this form has been submitted, you are expected to turn in all fees and forms by the due dates. If your forms and/or fees are not completed and turned in by the due date, you will no longer be allowed to participate. Any fees paid after the respective due date cannot be refunded.

Chaperone Commitment Form (Due November 21st)

Just as the students, we as chaperones must declare that and commit to all the responsibilities and standards that our job will involve. Fortunately, the company that is organizing the trip offers the chaperones a discount in price. They only need pay \$50.00 to participate. If you wish to do so, chaperones may earn their trip fees through fundraising as well. Please see the fundraising information for details.

Chaperone SMCPS Volunteer Form (Due November 21st)

All chaperones must complete the SMCPS volunteer form by November 21st and have that application approved in order to chaperone this trip. Ms. Oosterink and Mr. Oplinger will check with the LHS Administration to verify each chaperone's approval. The form can be found at http://www.smcps.org/safety-and-security/volunteer-information

\$100 Non-refundable deposit (November 21st)

Unfortunately, FourWinds travel requires that our organization put forth a non-refundable deposit which will be applied to our bill. The music budget cannot absorb this cost without your help. In the event that the trip must be cancelled, your deposit will be refunded. Thank you in advance.

Medical Information Form (Due March 15th)

To be distributed after Winter Break.

CHAPERONES & STUDENTS: For the safety of your children, we need as detailed information as possible on this form. In addition to insurance information, we need listed any medications that your child takes on a regular basis, the dosage, and how often that medication is taken. In the event of an emergency, we need to know to what medications (if any) your child may be allergic. For example, if you child cannot accept Tylenol or Penicillin (in a hospital E.R.) for whatever reason, we need to know that. Of course, all records will be kept confidential. In addition all chaperones must complete the same form.

LHS Field Trip Form (Due March 15th)

To be distributed after Winter Break.

This form must be completed by each and every student. On the form, there is insurance information needed, as well as a place for parent/guardian signature for approval of their participation in this trip. Because this is an overnight trip, your signature must be notarized. For those who aren't familiar with this process, a notary must validate that the parent/guardian (YOU) are the one who physically signed the form. They will verify with their signature and a stamp. Our main office staff can direct you to notaries in the area.

Fees & Fundraising

All students must pay \$875.00 to the LHS School Bank, Account #156 (Music Dept Trip Account) by the listed due dates (see next page). The fees are calculated in the following way:

NOTE: Once respective due dates have passed, ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. The only exception would be a refund of money BEFORE the respective due date occurs. Please understand that we would <u>love</u> to be able to refund your money, however, we pay every dollar to the companies responsible for allowing us to participate and our payment to them is equally non-refundable.

Participant Limits: 100 students, 10 chaperones

Due to the enormous expense of transportation, we must limit our numbers of students and chaperones who may participate. If we don't reach our minimum number of 100 students, we will have to cancel the trip. If the number of students goes above 100 we will put those additional students on a waiting list. Students and chaperones still on the waiting list by December 15, 2017 will be refunded their deposit. Students must pay their deposit to be counted as a participant or placed on the waiting list. Admission is first-come, first-serve by deposits paid to the LHS Bank. We will use Bank receipt numbers to determine acceptance order.

If more than 150 students enroll and make their deposit by the due date, we will order a third bus for the trip and the waiting list will be activated.

Fundraising

All students and chaperones may fundraise up to and above their entire trip cost. The chorus boosters are organizing several fundraisers throughout the school year. If you are interested in participating or wish to help organize a fundraiser, please see any of the music teachers for details.
