Volunteer Opportunities

Pit/Front Ensemble

GENERAL

Arrive at events 60 minutes prior to departure and/or the pre-game ceremonies

COMPETITIONS ONLY

Load equipment onto trailer before and after each performance, and assist with moving said equipment throughout the event

Assist with field set-up as outlined by the Director of Bands

Assist with removing equipment from the field following a performance

Assist with escorting students to the buses and equipment to the band trailer

FOOTBALL GAMES ONLY

Meet on the track during the last 8 minutes of the second quarter to move equipment onto the field prior to halftime and off of the field IMMEDIATELY following the performance

Stay for the remainder of the game and follow the band back to the band room with all equipment at the conclusion of the event



Chaperoning

Arrive at events 45 minutes prior to departure

Fill water bottles with ice and water in the cafeteria, and carry them throughout the course of the event Ride the bus to and from the event with the band

Assist with supervising students during travel and throughout the course of the event

Enforce all regulations as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct

Report issues needing disciplinary action to the Director of Bands

Escort students to the buses and/or the stadium following the performance

Assist with loading buses for departure

***Chaperones may NOT be on the field at any point during the performance unless approved by the Director of Bands ***



Concession Stands

EARLY SHIFT (starts at 4:30 PM)

Open concession stands and start fans

Open nacho cheese container and put it in the crock-pot to warm

Hang two price lists outside of the concession stand

Put candy out on trays

Pull gloves, foil wraps, fry bowls and nacho trays

Separate the band students' prepaid meals (*NOTE*: Ensure that Chick-Fil-A items receive priority during this procedure)

GRILL & FRYER

Remove hamburgers, hotdogs and condiments from wrappings and/or packages

Grill hamburgers, hotdogs and condiments

Wrap cooked hamburgers, cheeseburgers and hotdogs

Prepare the band students' burgers, hot dogs, sausages and fries prior to the start of halftime

Run food to stand as it becomes available

FIRST HALF (5:30 PM-halftime)

Sell food (Volunteers dealing with money should not handle food)

Fill cooler with sodas and candy for sale on the visitor side of the stadium

BAND STUDENT PRE-PAID MEAL DISTRIBUTION (after halftime)

Occurs near grill station

Get a cooler full of a variety of sodas and water for the band students' meals (Combo meals include either one soda or one water)

Check off each meal on the spreadsheet provided once they are distributed to the students

Direct students to the concession stand if they ordered cheese fries, candy, etc.

SECOND HALF (halftime-game's end)

Sell food (Volunteers dealing with money should not handle food)

Fill cooler with sodas and candy for sale on the visitor side of the stadium

Try to sell leftover burgers and hot dogs for ½ price once the game is over

Put everything away and lock up cabinets and refrigerator

Take inventory

To be completed by TWO volunteers: Count the money in each box and write the amount on the tally sheet provided

Clean counters and dispose of trash into the outside trashcans

Load crockpots and heating units into wagon so that they may be washed at home

Lock gill, fryer, freezer, storage room and the concession stand itself
