### **President's Report**

Discussed upcoming board nominations, did not receive nominations for Treasurer, Coordinating Secretary, Recording Secretary, and several Volunteer positions (Competition Sponsorship Coordinator, Website Assistant, Concessions Assistant, others).

In December, we will begin drafting new bylaws to go to one secretary position, and make the Webmaster a voting position. Intent to have affirmed by March so that board nominations can be completed by April so you know in May who you are voting for.

Robin put to vote President position, Jessica Bensel nominated and approved. Robin put to vote Vice President position, Pam Lange nominated and approved.

### **Vice President's Report**

We are missing \$300-400 for dine to donate, Pam called Panda Express and Pot Belly - came to LHS in March. We discussed getting out own PO Box.

### **Treasurer's Report**

Discussed drum major camp fees – total cost is \$499, vice \$400 budgeted. Total cost was approved.

Discussed needs of the band – Mr. Martin has requested an auxiliary cart and a wireless microphone

2018-2019 Budget - Paid \$2800 for 2019 competition, Moved from long term savings and paid it. Received \$291 for king and queen. Only 2 trailer sponsors want to renew - advertisements aren't allowed on school property. McKay's live on RT5 – could park the trailer there.

**ACTION:** Robin to line up auditor.

2019-2020 budget – Discussed changes since last time, moved trailer registration up to expenses, equipment and props split out, added \$860 microphones and \$1063 cart (propose - rather than buying from next year - buy now). Robin proposed to vote on the budget - caveat equipment maybe moved to next year - Joe seconded - all aye.

### **Fundraising Efforts**

Competition scheduled for 5 October, 13 schools signed up. We still need a sponsorship coordinator. The brochure to take to sponsors is ready to go. The list of sponsors is ready to go. We need someone to take the reins and assign people to go to certain vendors in June. We also need a team of people to split up the vendor list and ask for sponsorships. We also need a printer / copier / staples to do our programs for free.
